



Dear resident,

As you know Housing New Zealand is building 44 new homes at the vacant site on Oliphant Road, Bledisloe Place and Campbell Street in Hastings. These homes will be a mix of mostly state housing with some transitional housing. Transitional housing provides people in urgent need with a warm, dry and safe place to stay for around three months or more if required, while they find more permanent housing. Support services will also be provided onsite by a social services provider. Overall, the new development will provide much needed new warm and dry homes for Hastings.

The work will be starting the week of 4 March 2019 and the first stage of the development will take about six months to complete.

Work will be carried out Monday to Friday 7.00 am to 6.00 pm and Saturday 8.00 am to 5.00 pm. No work will be carried out on Sundays. Contractors will keep any disruption to a minimum.

To celebrate the beginning of this work we would like to invite you to a BBQ where you will have the opportunity to meet the builders undertaking the project. Housing New Zealand representatives will also be available to answer any questions you may have.
